2. S22-010B - State of Louisiana (General Obligation Bonds)

Receipt and consideration of bids at 10:00 a.m. on the sale of not exceeding \$250,000,000 State of Louisiana General Obligation Bonds, Series 2022A, adoption of the award resolution, and other matters related thereto.

Ms. Folse indicated Item 2 was for the General Obligation Bond sale to fund cash lines of credit for capital outlay projects in HB2 and explained the bid process. The lowest All-In True Interest Cost would be the winning bid, and once the bids come in, the bids will be verified by Lamont Financial Services.

Upon the close of the sale, Ms. Folse read in the bids. Additional information was provided by Mr. Bob Lamb (via telephone), President, Lamont Financial Services.

Treasurer Schroder acknowledged all of the work that went into executing the sale.

Ms. Heather Lamb (via telephone), Assistant Vice President, Lamont Financial Services, verified the bid results and confirmed Wells Fargo Bank, National Association was winning bidder, with a True Interest Cost of 3.037994.

Representative Christopher Turner, representing the Speaker of the House moved to accept the bid and the resolution, seconded by Senator Patrick Page Cortez, President of the Senate and without objection, the motion was approved.

3. S22-010C - State of Louisiana (General Obligation Bonds)

Receipt and consideration of bids at 10:15 a.m. on the sale of not exceeding \$50,000,000 State of Louisiana General Obligation Refunding Bonds, Series 2022B, adoption of the award resolution, and other matters related thereto.

Ms. Folse indicated Item 3, the refinancing of the General Obligation Refunding Bonds, Series 2022B, was removed from the bidding platform.
